# **Curricular Aspects**

ARIBAS has been accredited A grade by NAAC and Knowledge Consortium Gujarat for excellence in education and management in 2014. Ministry of Human Resource and Development, India has initiated a herculean task of ranking all the Indian universities through the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) based on Teaching & Learning Resources, Research, Professional competence, social outreach activities etc. ARIBAS has offered itself for evaluation and getting ranked. Looking to our past performance we are hopeful to get good ranking.

# M. Sc. Integrated Biotechnology

ARIBAS is offering five and a half year course after 12<sup>th</sup> science (B group). Total 115 applications were received this year out of which 49 students joined the course.

### Dissertation

As per the wish of Chairman Dr. C. L. Patel, ARIBAS offers dissertation to all final year students. As an institutional policy matter, all the students need to do in-house dissertation, Last year, 86 M. Sc. IGBT students completed dissertation in ARIBAS.

### Result

Overall the result was satisfactory, percent of students promoted to next semester was more than 97%. The number of students with ATKT status decline as students reach higher semesters and become more serious about their studies. This also shows the concerted efforts put in by faculties to improve their knowledge level and to motivate them towards studies.

### **Research Aptitude**

Our chairman, Dr. C. L. Patel has always emphasized on active and useful research activity in CVM institutions. To achieve his vision, ARIBAS is working categorically towards instilling research aptitude in students at an early age.

- Since last two year, restructuring of the seminar presentation and dissertation has been done.
- For all the students, starting from IGBT Sem I, seminar presentation is compulsorily on good quality research paper downloaded from Pubmed Central; the power point seminar is in front of whole of the class and evaluated by at least three teachers.
- The evaluation of dissertation, undertaken by final semester students, is done in three stages:
  - i. Project proposal evaluation by examiners in open seminar
  - ii. Mid- term evaluation in the form of poster presentation
  - iii. Final thesis evaluation and presentation
- > Checking the thesis for Plagiarism has been made mandatory for all.

### DST Sponsored INSPIRE Internship Camp

- M. Sc. Integrated Biotechnology Department organized 5 d Inspire Internship Camp for School students from 28<sup>th</sup> Nov. to 2<sup>nd</sup> Dec. 2015.
- Dr. Nilanjan Roy was Coordinator of the camp and ARIBAS received Rs. 9,75,000/- from DST, Govt. of India to organize the camp.
- The camp was absolutely free for students and all the expenses towards food, lodging and travel were met by ARIBAS from the grant received.
- 215 students from Anand and Kheda district, Vadodara, Ahmedabad and Nadiad were registered for the camp out of which 180 students have attended the camp for 5 days.
- During the camp, students got an opportunity to interact with eminent scientists and subject experts.

- Looking to the overwhelming response from schools, Department has submitted proposal to DST for second INSPIRE camp to be held in June '2016.

### **CSIR- NET Crash Course**

- GSBTM, Gandhinagar has entrusted ARIBAS as one of the centre for PG BT-CBC (Biotech capacity building cell).
- Under its auspices, Dr. Digvijaysinh Rana (Coordinator), faculty M. Sc. IGBT and team have successfully organized 02 crash courses of 5 days each in last one year for CSIR-NET preparation.
- First workshop was held from 22/05/2015 to 26/05/2015. A grant of Rs. 1,99,152/-was received from GSBTM for organizing workshop.
- In this, total 105 applications were received from all over Gujarat, out of which 31 were selected for crash course after screening.
- The workshop was conducted from 22/05/2015 to 26/05/2015 at ARIBAS, New V.V. Nagar, in which students were trained by NET qualified experts, wherein they not only shared their experience but also guided the students to strategically plan for NET examination.
- Students got free stud materials, boarding and lodging facility during the program.
- In the same manner, PG-BT CBC team coordinated by Dr. Digvijaysinh Rana also organized 5 d CSIR-NET crash course from 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> December, 2015.
