Curricular Aspects

M. Sc. Integrated Biotechnology

ARIBAS is offering five and a half year course after 12th science (B group). Total 109 applications were received this year out of which 52 students joined the course.

Dissertation

Last year, 73 M. Sc. IGBT students completed dissertation in ARIBAS.

Result

Overall the result was satisfactory, percent of students promoted to next semester is 100%. The number of students with ATKT status declined as students reach higher semesters and become more serious about their studies. This also shows the concerted efforts put in by faculties to improve their knowledge level and to motivate them towards studies.

Branding ARIBAS all over Gujarat

- It has been observed in last couple of years that there is an upsurge in Education Industry, with each region of Gujarat becoming self sufficient in higher education.
- To sustain in the changing scenario of education, ARIBAS has decided to focus locally especially Anand and Kheda district, Ahmedabad and Baroda. For this purpose M. Sc. IGBT faculties personally visited more than 90 schools in and around Anand, Baroda and Ahmedabad.
- ARIBAS is actively involved in spreading awareness about the career options and government fellowships available at various levels of education.

DST Sponsored INSPIRE Internship Camp

- M. Sc. Integrated Biotechnology Department organized second 5d Inspire Internship Camp for School students from 13th to 17th June 2016.
- Dr. Nilanjan Roy was Coordinator of the camp and ARIBAS received Rs. 9,75,000/- from DST, Govt. of India to organize the camp.
- The camp was absolutely free for students and all the expenses towards food, lodging and travel were met by ARIBAS from the grant received.
- 339 students from Anand and Kheda district, Vadodara, Ahmedabad and Nadiad, Surat, Aklaeshwar, Godhara were registered for the camp out of which 249 students have attended the camp for 5 days.
- During the camp, students got an opportunity to interact with eminent scientists and subject experts.
- Besides, learning the intricacies of basic sciences students got hands on training and career guidance.
- Looking to the overwhelming response from schools, Department has submitted proposal to DST for third INSPIRE camp to be held in June '2017.

CSIR- NET Crash Course

- GSBTM, Gandhinagar recognizes ARIBAS as one of the centre for PG BT-CBC (Biotech capacity building cell) and entrusted ARIBAS fourth time in row for organizing crash course.
- Under its auspices, Dr. Digvijaysinh Rana (Coordinator), faculty M. Sc. IGBT and team have successfully organized 02 crash courses of 5 days each in last one year for CSIR-NET preparation.
- First workshop was held 1st to 5th June 2016, A grant of Rs. 2,42,504/-was received from GSBTM for organizing workshop.
- In this, total 85 applications were received from all over Gujarat, out of which 50 were selected for crash course after screening.
- The workshop was conducted from at ARIBAS, New V.V. Nagar, in which students were trained by NET qualified experts, wherein they not only shared their experience but also guided the students to strategically plan for NET examination.
- Students got free study materials, boarding and lodging facility during the program.
- In the same mannerPG-BT CBC team coordinated by Dr. Digvijaysinh Rana also organized 5 d CSIR-NET crash course from 24th to 28th Nov. 2016.
- 70 applications were received. There was participation of 54 students and 20 experts from all over the Gujarat.
- To conduct this workshop ARIBAS received grant of Rupees 2,42,504/- from GSBTM.



Other Training Programs

 Two days Hands on Training programme on Bioinstrumentations was organized by Scintifiq club of ARIBAS from 17-18th of September 2016. Total 32 undergraduate students of N.V. Patel Science College and V.P & R.P.T.P Science college, V.V. Nagar have participated.

The students have received information, exposure and demonstration of various instruments like Lab. Scale Fermenter, U.V-Visible spectrophotometer, Gas Chromatography and HPLC.

Presently ARIBAS library has 5458 books.


