The academic calendar so prepared is put on institute's website so that teachers and students have easy access and prior information about the commencement of semester, number of working days, holidays and tentative dates for mid-semester and end-semester examinations. A time table is prepared for every department of the institute prior to the commencement of each academic semester by HOD in consultation with Academic Head and Director of the institute to carry out teaching in an organized and phased manner. The institute has a very clear vision about the planning and implementation of teaching schedules as per the academic calendar. Faculties of each department are instructed to complete their syllabi in time and conduct internal exams, seminars, assignments, quizzes, student projects, industrial visits, field trips and other activities as a part of their continuous internal assessment. Internal exams conducted before commencement of University Examination familiarizes the students about the pattern of examination. All the faculty members maintain course plan and lesson plan which are updated regularly. The institute works as per the academic calendar, which is planned well in advance and thus making it feasible to cover the syllabus in defined time frame. Additional classes are arranged as per the requirement to compensate loss of working days due to any reason. Whenever a faculty is on leave, alternate arrangement is made so that teaching does not suffer. The progress of teaching learning process is being continuously being monitored by HOD.
